This installation guide covers three topics:



To ensure you can successfully install the OnBase Unity client, you must first make sure you have the Microsoft .NET Framework 4 installed on your computer.


Checking your PC for Microsoft .NET Framework 4

To check whether you have the Microsoft .NET Framework 4 already installed, follow these instructions.

1. Click the **Start** button.
2. Select **Control Panel** in the right-hand menu.
The Control Panel displays.
3. Select **Programs and Features**.



4. Scroll down the list of installed programs.



Microsoft .NET Framework 4 should be listed.

5. If you don't find Microsoft .NET Framework 4 in the list of installed programs, follow the instructions below, *Installing Microsoft .NET Framework 4*.


Installing Microsoft .NET Framework 4

To install Microsoft .NET Framework 4, you must first download the software from the Microsoft website.

1. Open your internet browser.
2. Type the URL below into the location/address bar.
<http://www.microsoft.com/net/download>
3. Press **[ENTER]**.
The Microsoft webpage opens.

We will download and save the Desktop Install Package from the web before installing.

4. Locate and click the appropriate link on the web page:
[.NET Framework 4 Client Profile for x86 & x64](#) >

5. Click the **Download** button and follow the prompts to save the program.
6. Once the file completes downloading, locate it in your downloads folder and double-click it.
7. Follow the prompts to completion.

Installing the OnBase Unity Client

To install the OnBase Unity Client follow the instructions below.

1. Open Internet Explorer

NOTE: You *must* perform the following steps in **Internet Explorer**. Other browsers will not work with this installation procedure.

2. Type the URL below into the location/address bar:
<https://cactus.utdallas.edu/UTD/UnityClientUTD.application>
3. Press **[ENTER]**.
The Application Install program launches.
4. If you receive a Security Warning, click **Install**.



5. Once installation is complete, the Unity Client launches.

6. The first field should already contain the domain name, CAMPUS. If this is blank or incorrect, please change it.
7. Enter your NetID on the second line.
8. Enter your Password on the third line.
9. Click the **Login** button.

The Unity Client launches.
